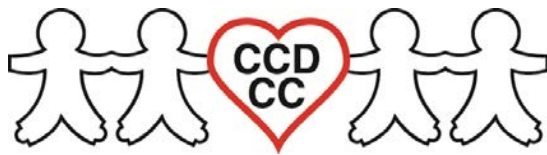

## 2012 FEES

### Weekly Rates (for up to 13.5 hours per day)

Infants (6 weeks – 18 months)	\$170.00
Toddlers (18 months – 36 months)	\$155.00
Preschool (36 months – 5 years)	\$139.00
School Agers (enrolled or eligible)	\$134.00

**No extra charges for 10 or more hours per day...fee includes up to 13.5 hours per day.**

### Daily rates (5 hours or more)

#### **Up to 13.5 hours per day**

Infants	\$40.00
Toddlers	\$37.00
Preschool	\$34.00
School Agers	\$34.00



### Half Day Rate (5 hours or less)

Infants	\$31.00
Toddlers	\$29.00
Preschool	\$27.00
School Agers	\$27.00

**Preschool Only:** \$120.00 per month – 2 days per week  
\$180.00 per month – 3 days per week

**Before and After School Only:** \$5.00 per hour

**Registration Fee:** \$50.00 per family annually

**Supply Fees:** \$5.00 per month per child, excluding infants

**Van Fee** (Burton, Cardinal, Hambden, Notre Dame and St. Helen's):  
\$30.00 per month for 1 child, \$40 per month for each additional child
